## DIVE INTO THE 26TH ANNUAL CORAL REEF SWIM RACE

wimmers near and far, beginners, amateurs or professionals, the 26th Annual Coral Reef Swim Race in beautiful and sunny St. Croix is waiting just for you! On Sunday, November 13th, one-mile, two-mile and five-mile race distances are being offered in the Coral Reef Swim Race for swimmers ready to make their way through St. Croix's crystal-clear waters. Often referred to as "Buck to Buc," swimmers participating in the five-mile race start at Buck Island National Monument and finish the race at The Buccaneer Beach & Golf Resort's Mermaid Beach. The shorter distances begin in alternate locations; however, all races end along Buccaneer's palm-lined beach.

The Buccaneer Beach & Golf Resort has been the host hotel of the race since its inception in 1995. Founded in the 17th century and family-run for generations, The Buccaneer offers elegant accommodations, golf, tennis, three exquisite beaches, two freshwater pools, kids' program, fine restaurants, water sports, spa, and fitness center on a 340-acre tropical estate. The resort owner, Elizabeth Armstrong, established the Coral Reef Swim Race with fellow swimmer Kim Sanford as a fundraiser for the East End Marine Park. The park was the first territorial marine park established to protect the natural and cultural resources of the east end of St. Croix. Discounted rates are available to participants through the resort's Swim Race Package. A minimum three-night stay and proof of registration is required.

Participants ages 11 and up can choose an assisted swim with fins and snorkel starting at \$90 per person for the 1-mile race. The two-mile and five-mile races are \$130 and \$150, respectively. # Message from Bry...





ince 2016, Dale and Yvette Browne of Sejah Farm VI have organized a local food competition on St. Croix that focuses on bringing community awareness on local food availability in the territory. Bush Cook Chef Cook is where the island's best and brightest chefs use their ingenuity to prepare unique dishes using locally grown crops and produce available to them. As an island with a 95% import rate, the ability to own, control

and consume our food is how we ensure food sovereignty and security in the U.S Virgin

Islands.

At 10am on Friday, October 21st, the threeday event kicks off with a free event featuring a host of family-friendly activities. Cooking workshops, elementary school cookoff, live music, farm tours and school supplies giveaway are a few of the activities to expect on Day 1. This day will also highlight ways to bridge the locally grown food gap between local farms and government assisted programs like SNAP & WIC. "We want the local food system to impact everyone," said Yvette.

"Oftentimes, families in these programs are unable to afford the best of the produce and crops available in the stores where they typically shop, and we want to change that for them."

The main event takes place on Day 2. This all-day cooking challenge is where trained chefs and home

cooks compete by preparing dishes using only locally grown ingredients and traditional cooking methods such as the coal pot, three stone setting or the pit oven. The cooking starts from 7am with food samples available from 1pm for attendees. Tickets are \$40 for adults, \$20 for children 6-12 years old and those under the age of 6 are free. Live music will be provided by DJs alongside the popular Cool Sessions

Brass plus enjoy a spirited performance from Guardians of Culture Moko
Jumbies. For the final day,
attendees will experience an

table dinner complete with five courses. The most formal event of the weekend, this dinner will be a collaboration prepared by the Bush Cook Chef Cook participants.


Attendees are welcome to bring their own bottles of wine, spirits and beer to enhance their farm-to-table dinner experience.

hen owners Damon and Yonka Maynard purchased Café Fresco in 2011, they never

would have on the community.

Now 11 years later, the husbandand-wife team are reimagining their restaurant with a revamped name in a new location.

Originally opened in 2005 under previous owners, the Maynards became the owners of Café Fresco in downtown Christiansted in July 2011. "We have worked in the restaurant industry for over 30 years," said Yonka. "The opportunity to purchase the business presented itself and

everything came together in a way we couldn't imagine." Noting it to be an easy transition, Yonka and Damon made the restaurant their own with delicious lunches made to order and exceptional service customers have come to expect and enjoy. Located on King Street in downtown Christiansted, Café Fresco's welcoming space in the courtyard of the historic Penthenny Building saw a multitude of people over the years. A physical sign hung over their door with the phrase "enter as strangers, leave as friends." The Maynards shared they have made more friends than anyone could ever deserve, which is why they are excited about welcoming friends into the next chapter.

October 28th will be the last day in their current location in downtown Christiansted. In December 2022, Café Fresco will officially become Fresco's Kitchen & Pub House at their new home in Gallows Bay. Customers can expect much of the same they've grown accustomed to with a few new details. This

larger space will include indoor and outdoor seating for up to 90 people alongside a full bar. Their indoor air-

conditioned space will have a sports bar feel with several TVs throughout the space playing your favorite sports games. The outdoor seating in the new courtyard features ample shade thanks to the large mango tree. Expanded hours will include evenings and weekends and a larger space means a bigger kitchen. "We're most excited about that," said Yonka. "We'll be able to have more help and create new dishes, which was a challenge in the previous location." Customers will be happy to know that menu favorites will be available in the new

location with new fun additions to the menu, not to mention a full bar with new cocktails, drinks and desserts. They also plan to host a weekly Sunday brunch that will segue into Sunday football.

The Maynards will use the month of November to get the new space ready for old friends and new ones. Interior designers Twila Wilson and Kobie Nichols are managing the décor and all the finishes in Fresco's Kitchen & Pub House where guests can look forward to a warm, welcoming space perfect for the entire family. "While we are changing the name slightly and moving to a new location, not much else is changing other than a renewed energy being injected into the restaurant."
